

## The “Destiny's Dartboard” Event Timing Spread

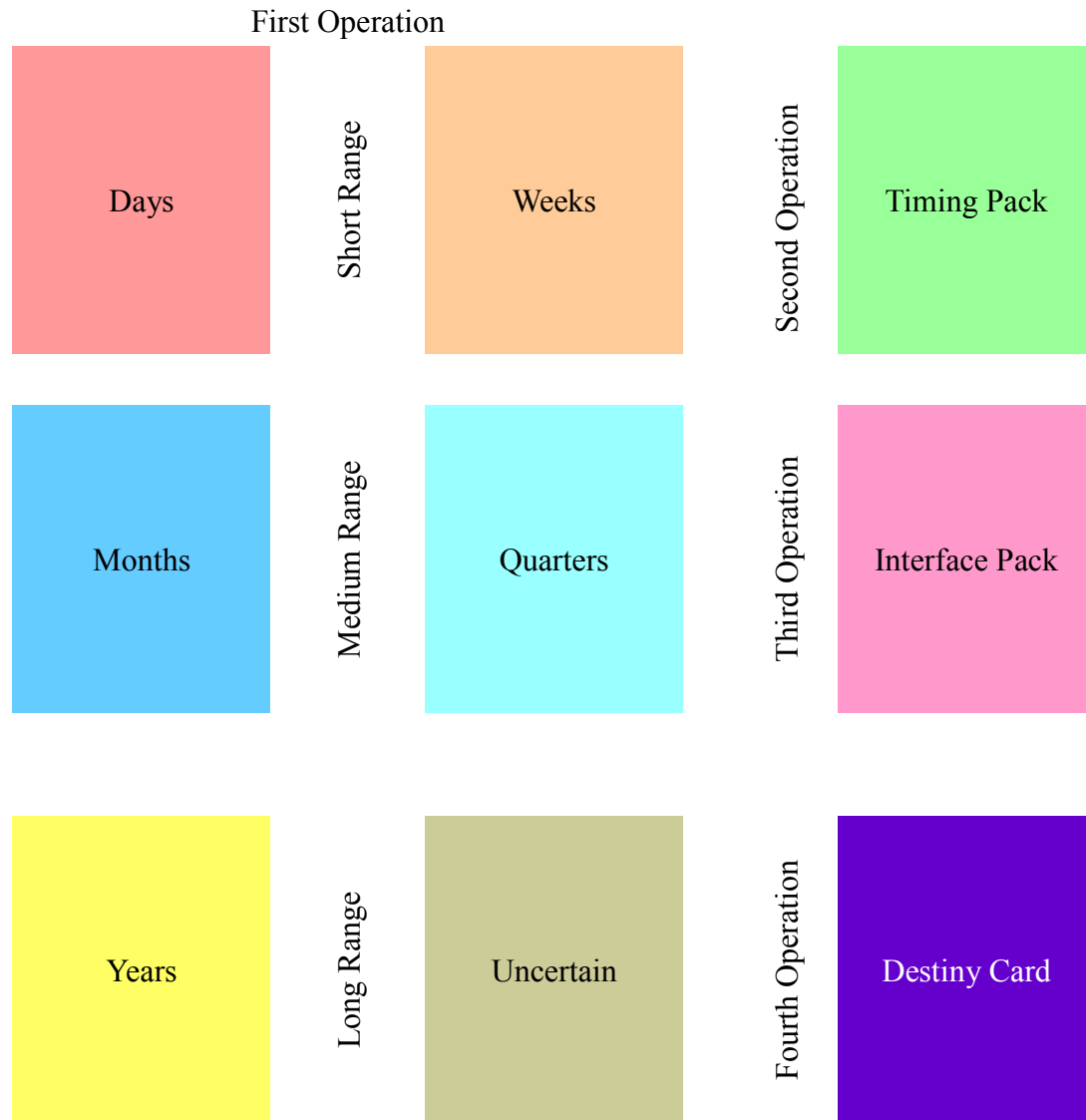
Decide which Ace represents the topic: Wands = Enterprise and Initiative; Cups = Affairs of the Heart; Swords = Decisions and Disputes; Coins = Material Matters. Leave it in the deck. (See the attached graphic.)

Shuffle and deal the cards face-up, from shortest to longest duration\*, until the chosen Ace appears. This will be the “ballpark” time-frame.

Remove the trump and court cards and reassemble the deck. Shuffle and deal the cards face-up into the “Timing Pack” until the first card of the chosen suit appears. This shows the **maximum** number of “units” of time (1-to-10) that will pass.

Shuffle and deal the 16 court cards face-up into the “Interface Pack” until the first card of the chosen suit appears. This shows whether someone will expedite (Knight, Page) or delay (King, Queen) completion of the matter. Knights and Pages are fast to act, Kings and Queens are slower.

Shuffle and cut the 22 trump cards, pull the top card from the stack and place it face-up on the “Destiny Card” This will show the role external forces will play in the outcome.



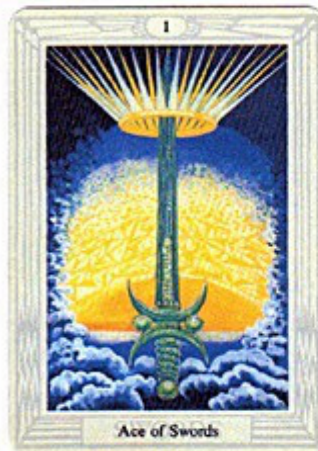
\*You may use only the most likely range if known. An “Uncertain” outlook can either terminate the reading or be subjected to judgment as to the most plausible time-frame.
